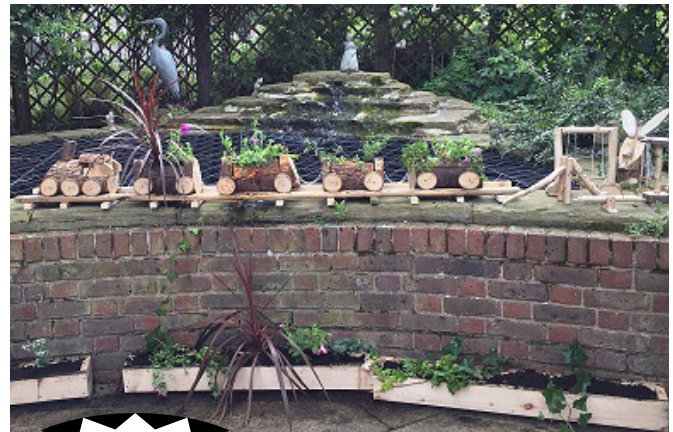


WoW Kids in Battersea Men's Shed
