## WoW Kids meet Prince William

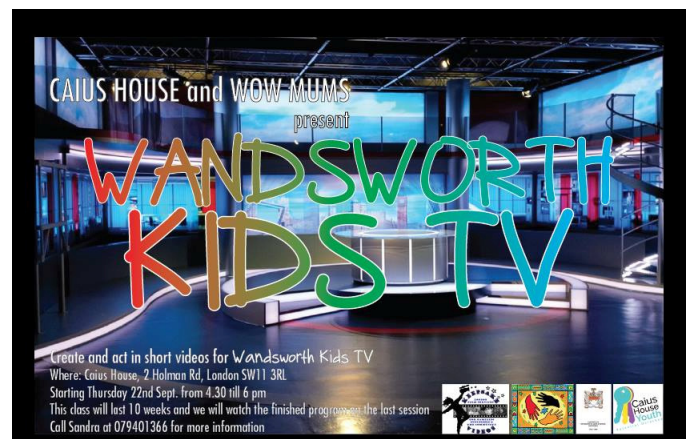
