200 million years old fossils of Dinosaurs andAmmonites. We have visited the Mary Anning science museum to see her incredible finds of fossils of Ichtiosaurus, which changed our knowledge about the history of Earth. Swimming in the sea with Fish &Chips at lovely Beer beach was a bonus.

We also visited awe inspiring

Beer Quarry Caves, where stone for Winchester, Exeter and St. Paul's Cathedrals, as well as for Westminster Abby and Tower Bridge were quarried for the last 2000 years from Roman, Saxon and Norman times to present day. Thank you to Aiming High Project and to SW Rotary Group for funding this trip.
