WoW Mums Senia Dedic has been honored by King Charles III in his New Year Honors List this winter and this month she has been invested with the Most Excellent Order of British Empire medal at the investiture ceremony. Just under 2000 people have been chosen for their public service from across the UK to be invested with various awards for their outstanding contributions in significant breath off services.

Order of British Empire is the largest order of Chivalry. It was instituted in 1917 by King George V, who wanted to recognise the service and sacrifice of people, from all areas of life, during the First World War.
