It has been a pleasure to give time and energy to support all our local children and families.



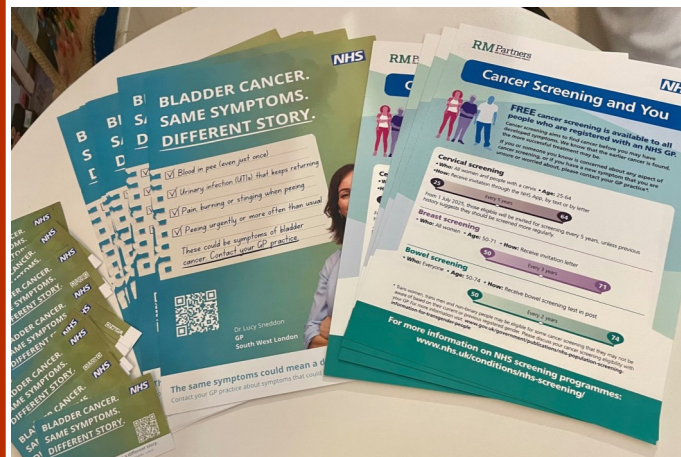
Parent Forum
